## Scholarship for Military Veterans

Claremont Lincoln University is pleased to offer San Diego SHRM members committed to changing the world the opportunity to apply for a scholarship valued at up to 50% of a student's tuition balance. San Diego SHRM funds are limited and only open to applicants who meet the eligibility criteria. Recipients will be selected by CLU's Scholarship Committee and notified of their award prior to the upcoming term date.

### ***Eligibility Criteria***

- Must be a military veteran transitioning to a civilian position.
- Must be admitted into a master's program at CLU and begin courses in 2022. If you are not enrolled yet, contact Leslee Patterson at [admission@claremontlincoln.edu](mailto:admission@claremontlincoln.edu).
- Applicant must be current member in good standing with San Diego SHRM and SHRM National.
- Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher (verified during the admission application process at CLU).
- Students must submit this completed application and all required documentation on or before **December 31, 2022** to [studentservices@claremontlincoln.edu](mailto:studentservices@claremontlincoln.edu).

### ***Scholarship Terms***

- Scholarship funds will be disbursed in installments each term not to exceed 50% of the student's term tuition.
  - Scholarship funds have no cash value and are only applied toward tuition charges.
  - Students must remain in good academic and financial standing or scholarship will be forfeited.
